

## ***CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE***

I hereby certify that per provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, Section 709.24 a citizen group has circulated a petition requesting that the Village of Riverlea be annexed to the City of Worthington and submitted them to the Board of Elections for signature verification. This petition consisted of eight (8) part petitions containing one hundred ten (110) signatures was filed on January 31, 2011.

One hundred three (103) signatures were determined to be valid signatures of electors in the Village of Riverlea. Per requirements of O.R.C., Section 709.24, twenty five percent of the number of resident electors voting at the last regular municipal election is required. At the General Election of 2009, two hundred ninety-seven (297) electors cast a municipal ballot in the Village of Riverlea at the General of 2009. Twenty-five percent (25%) of that number is seventy-five (75). Ninety-one (91) of the signatures on the petition were from resident electors voting at the specified election.

The Franklin County Board of Elections finds the petition to contain valid signatures equal to or greater than the number of signatures required under ORC 709.24.
