

The first meeting of the newly elected Council of the Village of Riverlea was called to order by the Mayor, Mr. Barber.

Mr. Barber then swore in the council members, the treasurer and clerk.

Minutes of meeting Friday, December 22, 1939, read by clerk. Approved.

Myers introduced the following ordinance and moved that it be placed upon its first reading. Clerk read ordinance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Marks. Thereupon a yea and nay vote on the motion was taken with the following results:

Yeth Brown, Mark, Myers, Russell, Ream Wood. Motion carried. Thereupon said ordinance was given its first reading.

Mr. Myers then moved that the rules requiring ordinances to be fully and distinctly read on three different days be dispensed with in respect of said ordinance and that it be placed upon its passage. The motion was seconded by Mr. Brown. A yea and nay vote was then had on the motion with the following result: Brown, Wood Marks, Myers, Russell, Ream. Motion carried.

Mr. Wood then moved the passage and adoption of said ordinance. The motion was seconded by Mr. Ream. Thereupon a yea and new vote was taken on the passage and adoption of said ordinance with the following resule: Vote Brown, Myers, Marks, Russell, Ream, Wood.

The Mayor then declared said ordinance #7, duly passed and adopted.

Mr. Ream moved that the zoning ordinance amendment to ordinance #6 be passed as submitted by the zoning committee. Seconded by Brown. Vote, unanimous.

Brown, Mayes, J. H. Wood, Reem, were appointed to review the zoning ordinance and be the zoning commission to run concurrently with their term of office.

Mr. Myers moved that the clerk receive \$10.00, per month to compensate for the work necessary to keeping records, etc. Brown seconded. Vote, unanimous.



The mayor instructed the clerk to have issued bonds required by law on municipal officer.

Mayor Barber appointed Reem the new street commissioner.

Mr. Russell moved that the village assume the bill of Mr. Harter of \$35.00, for legal advice for the village. Seconded by Wood. Vote unanimous.

Mr. Barber appointed to the Building Committee, Mr. Myers, to act as Chairman and Inspector. to act with present Committee members

Mr. Marks was appointed Safety Director for his term of office.

It was moved by the Mayor and seconded by Russell that the council meet on Friday, January 12, 1940.

There being no further business to come before council it was adjourned.

Myers of Zoning Committee reported on the zoning ordinance amendment.

Mr. Gibbens of Columbus, reported with Mr. Myers on the difference between this and our new emendment. Russell moved that the amendment be accepted in toto as submitted by the Zoning Committee. Seconded by Mark. Vote, unanimous.

Marks moved that the Zoning Committee be empowered to further improve and add to the Zoning Ordinance and submit their findings to Council. Seconded by Wood. Vote, unanimous.

Mayor Barber talked to Barker and Cook as to a set yearly fee to police the village and suggested they submit to Safety Director their plan.

There being no further business to come before Council a motion to adjourn was in order. Moved by Ream that Council meeting adjourn. Seconded by Myers.
